It is not recommended that you attempt more than 1 Unit 3-4 subject in Year 11. Being enrolled in a Units 3-4 subject in Year 11 does not entitle you to undertake fewer subjects in Year 12. ALL Year 12 students will be expected to undertake 5 Year 12 subjects in their final year. Exceptions will only be made in very rare circumstances.

Students who have completed two VCE Unit 1-2 studies in Year 10 will not automatically be permitted to undertake two Unit 3-4 studies in Year 11.

Applications which do not include the recommendation of your current Year 10 subject teacher or Coordinator will not be considered.

**Note:** Students are required to select **one unit** of **Personal Development** each semester.
