

Career Pilot at Holmesglen

Career Pilot is a fantastic opportunity to support young people in south east Melbourne who have struggled to gain employment and aims to focus on building new skills, gain confidence and provide tailored workplace experience to support these young people.

This 12 week program will include:

- Professional careers counselling
- Understanding of employment and study pathways
- Industry exposure and tailored work experience placement
- Teaching of job-readiness skills such as communication and confidence skills.

- To be eligible you must be 15-25 years old with a senior secondary qualification or be currently unemployed or complete less than 10 hours per week.
